

Recyclable Materials Guide:

Recyclable materials do not need to be sorted, place all materials loose in the recycling cart. Do not bag items.

 <p>Aluminum All types, should be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• clean• free of liquid• cans crushed or uncrushed	 <p>Cardboard Corrugated non-wax, any type:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean• flattened• remove any wax or plastic liners <p>beer/soda cardboard packaging is not recyclable</p>
 <p>Plastic Bottles- #1 and #2's ONLY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• rinsed clean• caps removed <p>At this time, plastic grocery/shopping bags are not recyclable.</p>	 <p>Glass Bottles and Jars ONLY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• rinsed clean• caps removed• Can be mixed: Clear - Brown - Green <p>The following items are not recyclable: Window glass, pottery, ceramics, dishes and ovenware. They are considered demolition.</p>
 <p>Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• newspaper• magazines• office paper• junk mail <p>Clean and dry ONLY.</p>	 <p>Tin</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Food cans <u>ONLY</u>• rinse clean <p>Clean and dry ONLY.</p>

***All other non-corrugated packaging such as tissue boxes, cereal boxes, and other food packages are not recyclable and should be placed in the garbage with other solid waste.**
